- 9. Bond Insurance was presented by the Clerk. State Statute requires it on the Clerk and Treasurer. The Clerk obtained pricing through Rural Insurance. - Road work for this year will focus on gravel roads, no asphalt projects are planned. The Clerk informed the Chair regarding the need to spend an average of \$2500 per mile in order to receive the maximum amount of General Transportation Aid from the State.
